Admissions Update

To be considered for transfer admission you must meet the following minimum requirements by the end of the prior **<u>Spring 2021</u>** for Fall 2021 admission:

Grading Reminder for Winter 2020 – Summer 2021

- The CSU will accept grades of "Credit" or "Pass" to satisfy Golden Four Requirements, general education, and major prerequisite courses taken during the Winter, Spring and Summer 2020 & 2021 terms.
- Grades of "Credit" or "Pass" will not be included in the transfer GPA calculation.

All applicants will receive an email acknowledging that we received their application and will include their CSUDH Student ID Number (9-Digits) as well as instructions on how to setup their student portal (My.CSUDH).

FALL 2021 ADMISSIONS DEADLINES

February 2, 2021

CSUDH will begin announcing admissions decisions.

October 1, 2020 – March 2, 2021

Complete the FAFSA or CA Dream Act by the priority deadline and the Intent to Enroll deposit will be waived for all students with a Zero EFC. FAFSA: <u>studentaid.gov/</u>

March 29, 2021

April 1, 2021

Newly admitted students will be allowed to change their major up through April 1, 2021. After April 1 or after they register for NSO, whichever comes first, student will no longer be able to change their major until the start of the academic year.

Intent to Enroll non-refundable deposit: \$125
New Student Orientation non-refundable fee: \$99

<u>June 30, 2021</u>

Deadline to submit final, official transcripts. However, we recommend students get their final, official transcripts in at least 5 days prior to their New Student Orientation date to ensure sufficient time for admission to complete a transfer credit evaluation.

Be a Toro and submit the \$125 non-refundable Intent to Enroll Deposit on <u>My.CSUDH.edu</u> by May 1, 2021. This deposit will be applied to your fall 2021 tuition.

Register & Pay for New Student Orientation (NSO)

Register and pay the \$99 non-refundable New Student Orientation (NSO) Fee. Orientation dates are by college and payment must be cleared to secure your spot at NSO. NSO is a mandatory enrollment requirement so check your schedule before registering for NSO. Students have until May 1, 2021, to register for NSO or change a current NSO reservation date.
